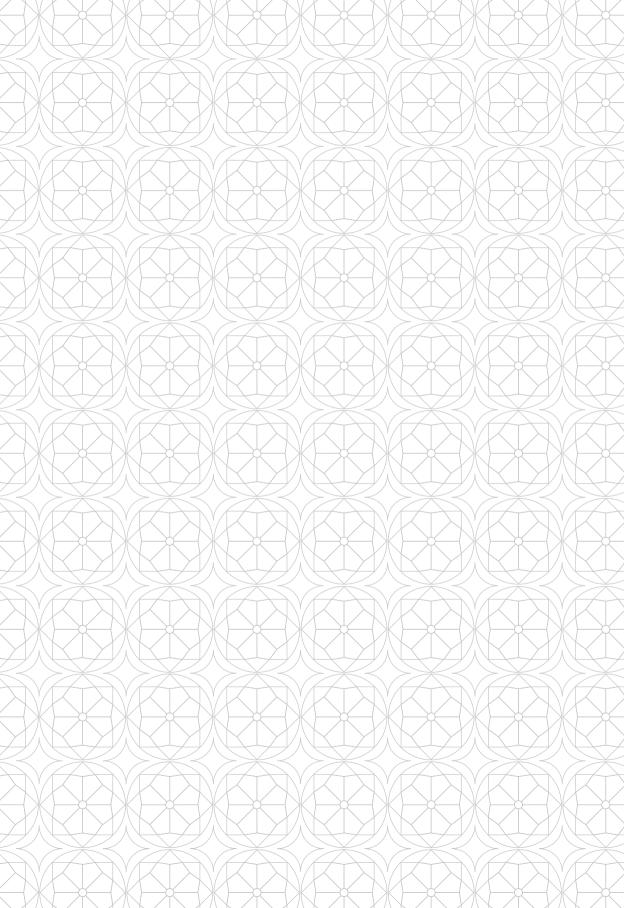


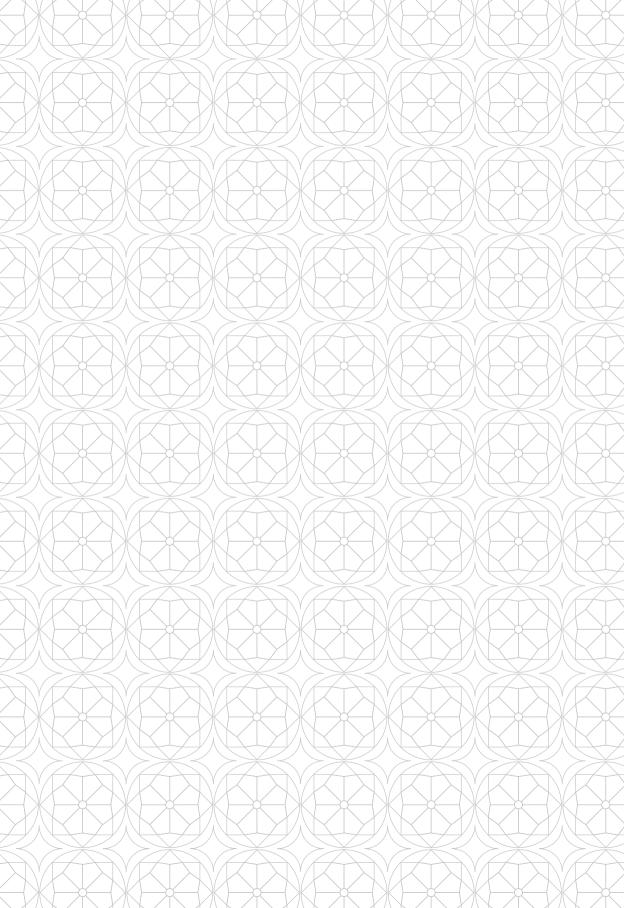

### Decrees



#### Amiri Decree No. (7) of 2022 Concerning Abu Dhabi Equestrian Club

#### We, Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Ruler of Abu Dhabi,

Having reviewed:

- Law No. (1) of 1974 concerning the reorganisation of the Governmental body in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and its amendments;
- Law No. (4) of 2011 concerning the establishment of Abu Dhabi Sports Council;
- Federal Law by Decree No. (7) of 2008 concerning the General Authority of Youth and Sports Welfare, the operational entities thereof and its amendments; and
- Based on what was presented to and approved by the Executive Council, Issued the following Decree:

#### Article (1)

His Highness Sheikh Mansoor bin Zayed Al Nahyan shall be the Chairman of Abu Dhabi Equestrian Club.

#### Article (2)

The Chairman of the Club shall issue a resolution concerning the formation of the Board of Directors, that shall consist of five members at least including the Chairman of the Board of Directors and his Vice-chairman; the resolution shall state the competencies of the Board of Directors, its powers, its functioning system and the remuneration of its members.

#### Article (3)

The Chairman of the Club may delegate any of his competencies to the Chairman of the Board of Directors or the Director-General; and the delegation shall be in written and specific.

#### Article (4)

Any provision contrary to the provisions of this Decree shall be repealed.

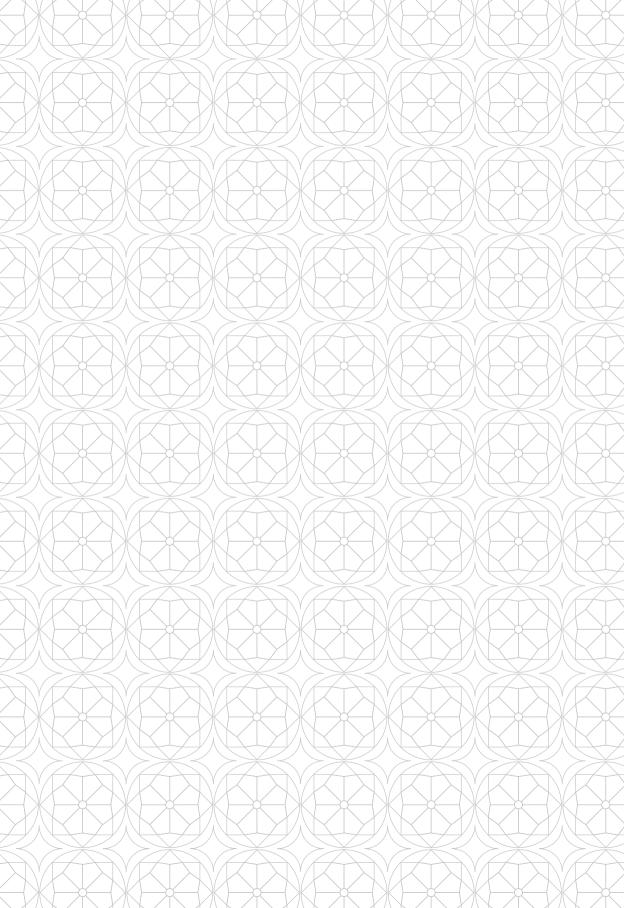
#### Article (5)

This Decree shall be effective from the date of its issuance and published in the Official Gazette.

## Concerning the Appointment of the Undersecretary of the Department of Education and Knowledge


